

2021 Hometown Hero Banner Program Guidelines

Unfortunately we cannot accommodate location requests for banner installations.

Mission

Honor and recognize Upper Perkiomen Valley servicemen and women who have served or given their lives to our country in the United States Armed Forces.

Application Requirements

In order to be considered for a banner, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

1. Lived in the Upper Perkiomen Valley area at some point in their lifetime
2. Served in one of the following branches: Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, National Guard, Coast Guard
3. Meet one of the following criteria: honorably discharged Veteran, died in the line of duty

Banner Design, Time Frame & Location

Banners are 24"x 48", double sided, vinyl material and include service person's name, branch of service, era of service and photograph. Banners will be displayed on telephone poles along Main Street for a two-year period. Banner locations will be selected randomly and specific display locations cannot be requested.

Banner Photograph

Please submit an original photograph of the Hero in uniform to the Chamber.
The photograph will be scanned at the office while you wait.

Banner Pricing & Donations

A \$185.00 donation is requested for each banner application submitted. Donation includes the production of the banner, installation and removal. If the full donation amount is a hardship, please check the box on the application to "request consideration for sponsorship." There are a limited number of locations available for the 2021 program. Applications not processed for 2021 will be put on a waiting list for the 2022 Banner Program. All checks should be made payable to PerkUp Corporation (reference "Hometown Heroes" on the check) or call the Chamber office to pay by credit card.

Banners will be available for pickup at the borough in which it was installed after the display period. Unclaimed banners will become property of PerkUp Corporation. Any damage to an installed banner will be handled at the discretion of PerkUp Corporation. Banners as surprises to living individuals are not permitted.
